HOW BUSY IS OUR ORCHARD PARK PUBLIC LIBRARY?

In 2014 we were the **second** most visited library in the Buffalo and Erie County Library System. In 2015 from January through June there were:

- -142,250 books checked out
- -11,189 hours of computer usage
- -98,011 visits (as recorded by the RFID gate counter)
- -4788 library WiFi sessions

In May and June of 2015 there were 55 library programs for adults and children and 21 community programs.
